1. Any LEGO bricks provided by the organizer that remain after completion of the project must be returned to the organizer.
2. The copyright and ownership of our team’s project belong to our team.
3. If our project is selected as an award-winning project, we agree that the organizer may install and exhibit the project in exhibition spaces on campus.
4. If our project is selected as an award-winning project, we agree that photographs and videos of the project may be used in university promotional materials, including websites, printed materials, press releases, and social media.
5. The organizer will indicate our team name when exhibiting or promoting the project.
6. The organizer will make every effort to ensure the safe exhibition and storage of the project. However, the organizer shall not be held responsible for any damage to or loss of the project caused by circumstances beyond its control.
7. If our project is selected as the Grand Prize-winning project, we agree to donate the project to the university after the awards and allow it to be permanently installed and exhibited in an exhibition space on campus.
8. If our project is selected for the Excellence Prize or Merit Prize, we agree that the project may be installed and exhibited in an exhibition space on campus for six months.
9. Within 30 days after the end of the exhibition pursuant to Clause 8, the team may request the return of and retrieve the project. If the team does not retrieve the project, it will be deemed to have donated the project to the university.
